Boil Water Notice Rescinded
1/1/2024

On 12/29/2023 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the City of Strawn public water system, TX 182005, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of 1/1/2024.

This boil water notice was issued as a precautionary action because pressure was lost on 12/29/2023 for all customers north of the railroad tracks during scheduled pipeline construction. We have received confirmation from an independent lab that water in the affected areas has tested negative for any contamination due to the loss of pressure.
